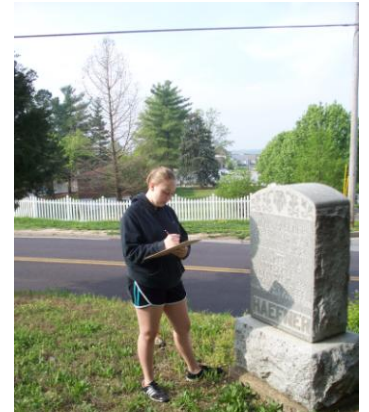
Ridgewood School Students Learn How to Record Gravestone Information at Richardson Cemetery

On April 28 these students and others will clean up brush from 9-11 a.m. at the old Ulrich Cemetery on Gary Road, 1 mile west of Tomahawk and Vogel Road intersection; or ½ mile east of Rock Creek Road. The cemetery dates back to 1846 when St. John's Lutheran Church wanted to build a log church at that site. Those plans changed but the cemetery remains. Workers will need to wear long pants, long sleeved shirts, sturdy shoes and bring gloves.
