

The Arnold Historical Society's Float in the Arnold Days Parade



The Arnold Days Parade was held September 16 with a theme to celebrate 40 years of being incorporated as a City. The Society's float featured Roy Wilde who had retired from serving on the City's Planning and Zoning Commission for 38 years. Roy was appointed to serve in 1974 by Mayor Ferd Lang. This float won third place, and the Society received \$200. The second part of the Arnold Historical Society float featured the Arnold family descendants being driven in a '30 Chevy Phaeton. On the left is Louis Arnold, a grandson of the Arnold's for whom the City is named. Joining him was Ross Ford whose mother was Georgia (Arnold) Ford, also a granddaughter of the City's namesake. As you can see from the final picture, these two entries were the end of the parade.
