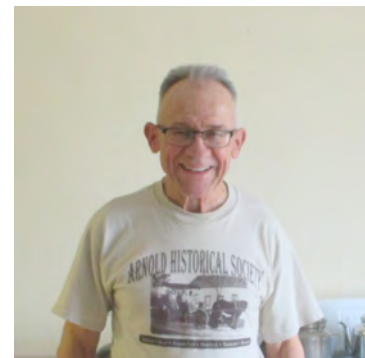

PROPOSED CAR Show Set for Aug. 11 in Arnold City Park "Under The Trees"



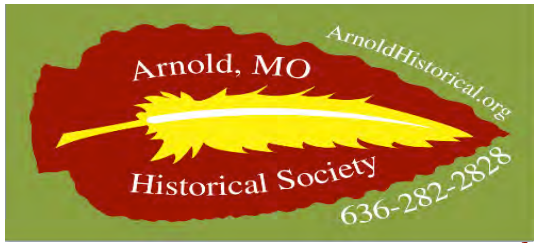
Discussion about holding the Car Show centers around not having many active members who can help put on this event. Weather is always a question mark. And the cash outlay is large.
