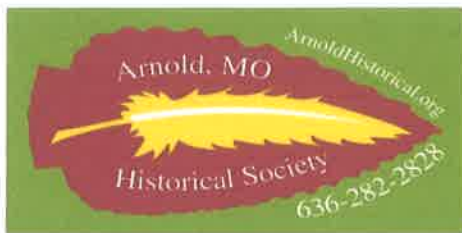

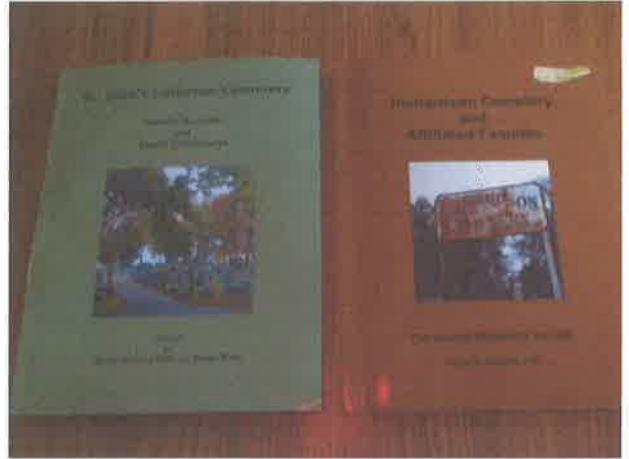

These are the law books of Judge Bernard Meese from the 1930s. On the left we read that the Judge performed a wedding on Oct. 16, 1932 for Elmer Riedy and Mary Paulik. On the right page: on May 5, 1939, James Greg brings a suit against Helen Graham for unlawful detainer of \$50 for monthly rent and profit. On May 23, 1939, Justice of the Peace Harry Frederitzi and Constable Joseph Brockhaus of Rock Township levied the personal belongings of Helen Graham and sold her personal belongings for \$31.00



There are several copies of both St. John's Lutheran Cemetery and Richardson Cemetery at the Museum. Cost is \$20 per book. Inside you will find a listing of each person buried and some information about them. These are some of the people who lived in the Arnold area long before it was called Arnold. Also included are death certificates describing what that person died of.
